Mediums

- Graphite Pencils, e.g., Staedtler Mars Lumograph Black Artists Pencils (contains graphite with some charcoal, intensive values but harder to erase) <u>or</u> Staedter Drawing Pencils (contains graphite only, blue body). Set of HB has 2B,4B, 6B, 7B and 8B. Open stock, minimum B, 2B, 4B, 6B.
- Optional: Progresso Graphite Woodless Pencils, 2B, 4B, 9B
- Optional: Graphite Bars, 2B, 4B, 6B
- Coloured Pencils and/or Pastel Pencils Derwent Coloursoft or Prismacolor Premier Coloured Pencils.



Tools

- Kneaded Eraser
- Blending Tools options are steel wool (plain, not the soap/scrubber), chamois or swatch of cotton. A worn down bristle brush is good for scumbling. A tortillon is helpful to smudge and blend marks
- Mahl Stick (to prevent smudging paper while you work)
- Butterfly Clamps
- Green Painter's Tape
- Viewfinder
- Value Scale
- Utility Knife (retractable, with snap-blades for pencil sharpener)
- Wax Paper Roll (used to protect drawings in lieu of fixative)
