



Simple Reflections Art & Culture Showcase spotlights Global Artists with Local Roots

Museum London is proud to host the Simple Reflections Art & Culture Showcase on Saturday, March 28, a free event celebrating the diverse cultures and lived experiences that have shaped London's creative community, presented in partnership with Simple Reflections for Artists.

The showcase will feature more than 80 local musicians, dancers, and visual artists whose work reflects traditions from around the world. Throughout the day, live painting and musical performances will animate the Centre at the Forks, offering a dynamic program that blends global artistic styles. Visitors are encouraged to explore the visual arts showcase, and engage with artists as they create in real time.

The event is presented in collaboration with Simple Reflections for Artists, a collective founded to remove barriers for local artists who have come from around the world to make London their home. Through visual and performing arts, the collective fosters connection by bridging culture and community.

“In many parts of the world, festivals are built through a collective effort, with each person contributing what they can,” says Simple Reflections founder Dario Novoa. “That spirit of collaboration lives here in London. Our Bicentennial year is an opportunity to celebrate not only where we began, but who we have become together.”

As part of the celebration, Simple Reflections will debut a special bicentennial music video, commemorating iconic landmarks and moments from London’s musical history.

“London has always had a strong musical heartbeat, and the bicentennial is the perfect time to celebrate the artists who shaped it,” says Mario Circelli, co-chair of the Forest City London Music Awards. “We’re excited to launch a music video highlighting local artists from the city’s musical history, set to the original song *The Forest City* by Simple Reflections for Artists.”

The Simple Reflections Art & Culture Showcase is entirely volunteer-led and co-created by local artists. Museum London is proud to support this initiative alongside community partners that include the Digital Creative Arts Centre, the Forest City London Music Awards, and Downtown London.
